Changes include:

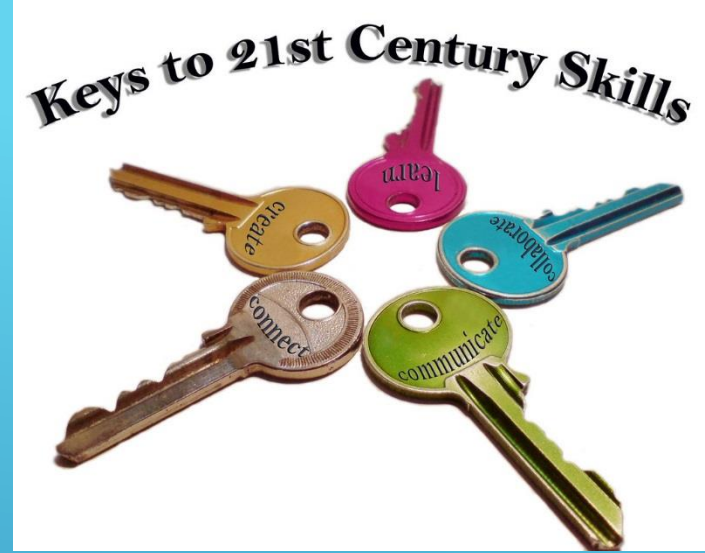
- Partners needed to assure support

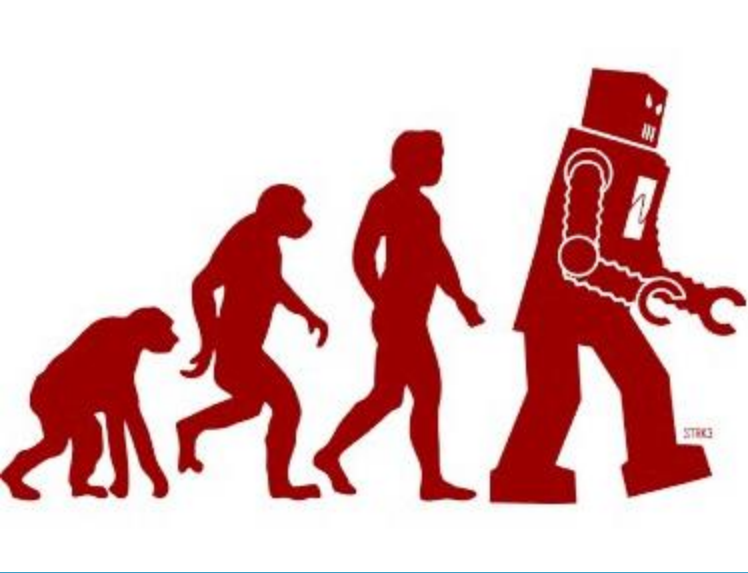
